The Washington Marriott Capitol Hill Hotel is part of a new, mixed-use development, called NoMa Center, that has been in planning for more than a decade on the site of a former Greyhound bus terminal. It opened on January 11, 2022. Sophisticated public areas are designed by award-winning local Washington, DC-based designer, Darryl Carter. The hotel design applies contemporary forms and angular shapes that are both unexpected and dramatic. Materials are polished and refined, with hints of strong metals and warm woods.
